## Finance Committee Wednesday, August 28, 2019 @ 9:30-10:30am La Ventana Conference Room, SCOE, 5340 Skylane Boulevard, Santa Rosa Minutes Approved at the October 4, 2019 Meeting

- 1. Call to order. Chair Missy Danneberg called the meeting to order at 9:40am.
- 2. Approval/Changes to agenda. The agenda was approved as submitted by unanimous consent.
- 3. No public comment on non-agendized items.
- 4. On motion by Missy Danneberg and second by Margie Vondrak, the minutes of the joint Finance & Executive Committee meeting of 6/21/2019 were approved with Margie Vondrak abstaining.
- 5. Review 2018-20 final expenditures: Susy reviewed each ending balance for each resource with the committee.
- 6. First 5 Sonoma Contracts carryover update. CARES and the Quality Counts Local will rollover; but the IMPACT contract will not.
- 7. Center for the Study of Child Care Employment Workforce Study. Susy explained that the state is working on a work force study for the state, but that some counties (including Sonoma County) are eligible to complete their own local study. The cost of the local study is \$36,000 ... and Susy is look for funding partners for this more inclusive sampling. The Community Foundation will fund \$5,000 ... other possible sources are the Economic Development Board and First 5. First 5 will lead and give staff time to this project. On motion by Missy and second by Margie, the committee voted to approve \$2,500 to this project, with the possibility of up to \$5,000 should the funds become available.
- 8. 2019-2020 Budget. Susy pointed out that funds 5035 and 5055 show negative ending balances in salaries but an HRA (Human Resources Action) retroactive to July 1<sup>st</sup> will correct it. AB 435 (Pilot Work) should fund at least the Year 1 report. One notable change is that CSPP \$18,957 needs to be spent by September 30, 2019. This year assessments will be heavy with an additional\$15K to support that work. The budget is decreasing from year to year, but has increased from what the Council approved in May.
- 9. The next meeting was set for Friday, October 4 at 11:00am.
