- Advocate for EL students

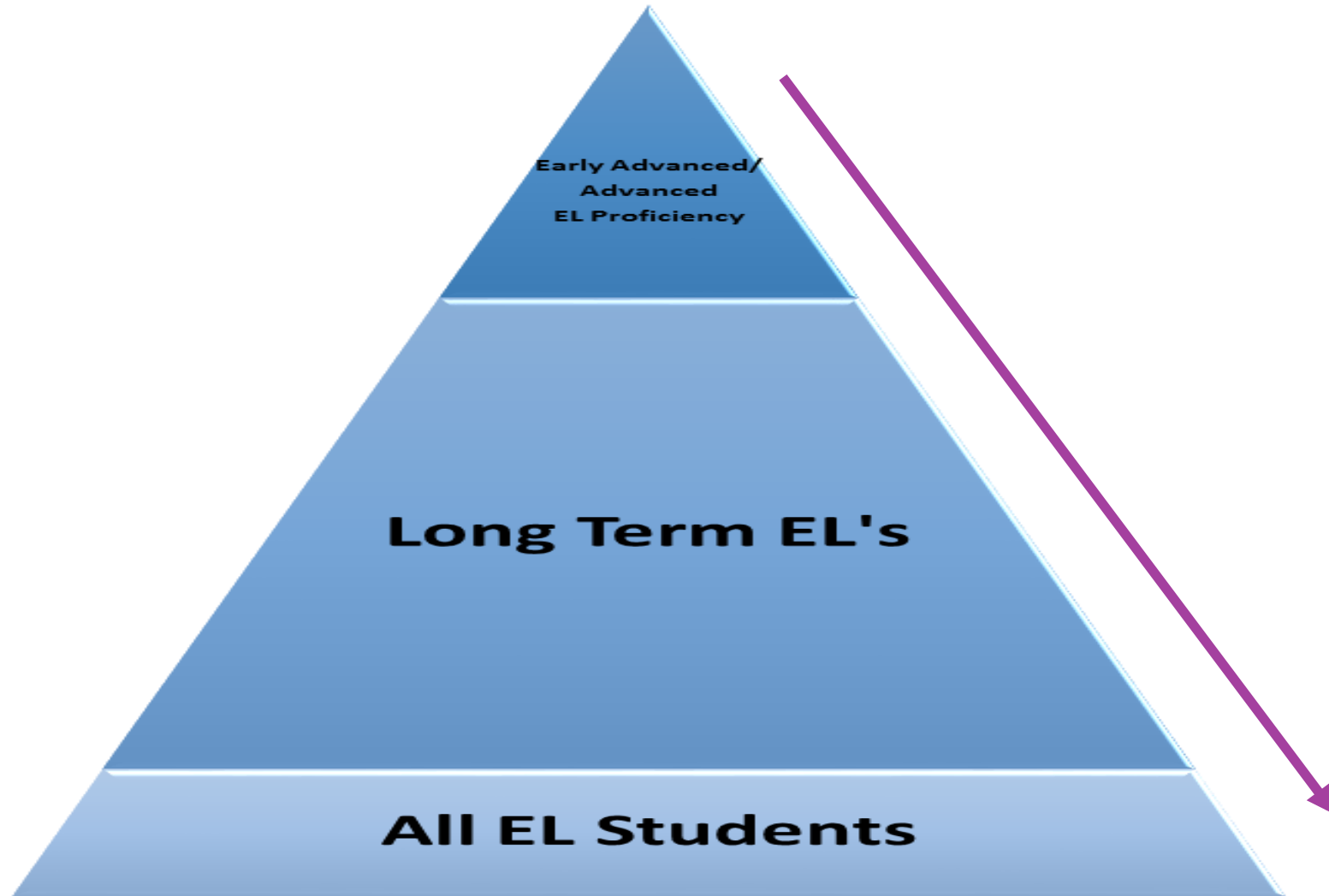
How/Why did it come about?

- 84% of EL students are LTELs
- Need to close the achievement gap within our district

How many SOLL counselors are there?

- Currently, there are 4 counselors focusing on secondary grades 7-12
 - Average caseload - 400

What challenges have you seen?

- New/non traditional counseling position
- Multiple sites / logistics
- Connectivity to school site staff

What successes have you seen?

- 270 additional students identified for reclassification
- Increase in parent/community involvement
- Stakeholders taking ownership of their learning
- Proper class placement through schedule reviews

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
