2 These districts receive augmented funding from various sources, such as local property tax revenues, small school funding, or special federal funding.

3 Enrollment for Harmony Union includes a charter school with 546 students. Enrollment for Liberty includes a charter school with 787 students.

4 Petaluma and Santa Rosa are combined administration districts and per student expenditures include both elementary and secondary.
