1—The Academic Performance Index (API) is the 2010 API Base score, which is on a scale of 200 to 1,000. The state has set 800 as the API score that schools should strive to meet. Alternative schools, K-1 schools, and new schools do not have API scores. API scores based on small numbers of students are less reliable and therefore should be carefully interpreted.

Schools that receive APIs are ranked in deciles by grade level (elementary, middle, and high). A rank of 10 is the highest. Schools are ranked on a statewide basis and also compared to schools that share similar demographic characteristics. Very small schools, alternative schools, and schools that did not test 65% of their students are not ranked.

2—Lawrence E. Jones Middle School opened in 2010-11 when Creekside and Mountain Shadows middle schools were combined. Its first API scores will be reported in 2011.

3—Oak Grove Union School District reconfigured their schools in 2008-09, creating Oak Grove Elementary/Willowside Middle School as a charter school operating on two campuses. The 2010 API Base score and rankings are for that new school.

4—Spring Creek and Matanzas schools were combined into one charter school operating on two campuses. The 2010 API Base score and rankings are for that new school.

* These schools have received state Distinguished School recognition more than once. The year indicated is the most recent.
