<b>Extension of 2022 Paid Covid-19 Sick Leave</b> Aaron Burton		<p>Looking to address a lapse in agreements and hope to get a new one in place to align with the one currently in place.</p> <p>There was discussion about the state/number of current cases.</p> <p>The current SPSL (covid leave) expires Sept 30th.</p> <p>Ms. Britton asked if we have information about how many employees still have some of that leave left to use? Mr. Laughlin said we could look into that.</p> <p>Dr. Herrington said we can extend it incrementally, until January. There was discussion about meeting in advance of the winter break. That would allow people to use the existing bank for an extended period of time. There was also a suggestion to access the catastrophic leave bank for additional leave.</p>

		<p>county that were person-to-person contracted cases.</p> <p>Universal precautions have been advised.</p> <p>They have vaccines in this county and are using them in the high risks groups first.</p> <p>Ms. Corbin shared that she can include reminders to use universal precautions on her blog.</p>
