

Covid-19 Vaccine Clinics for Families & Students ages 12 and older

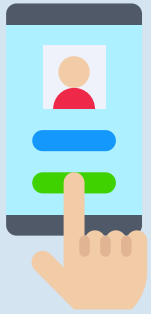

Identification with your date of birth is preferred, but it is not required to receive a vaccine.

Parental Consent Required for Students Under 18

Students under age 18 must have signed parental consent.

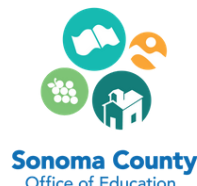
Children age 12-15: MUST have a parent /guardian present at the clinic.

Youth age 16-17: only need a consent form signed by their parent/guardian.
