

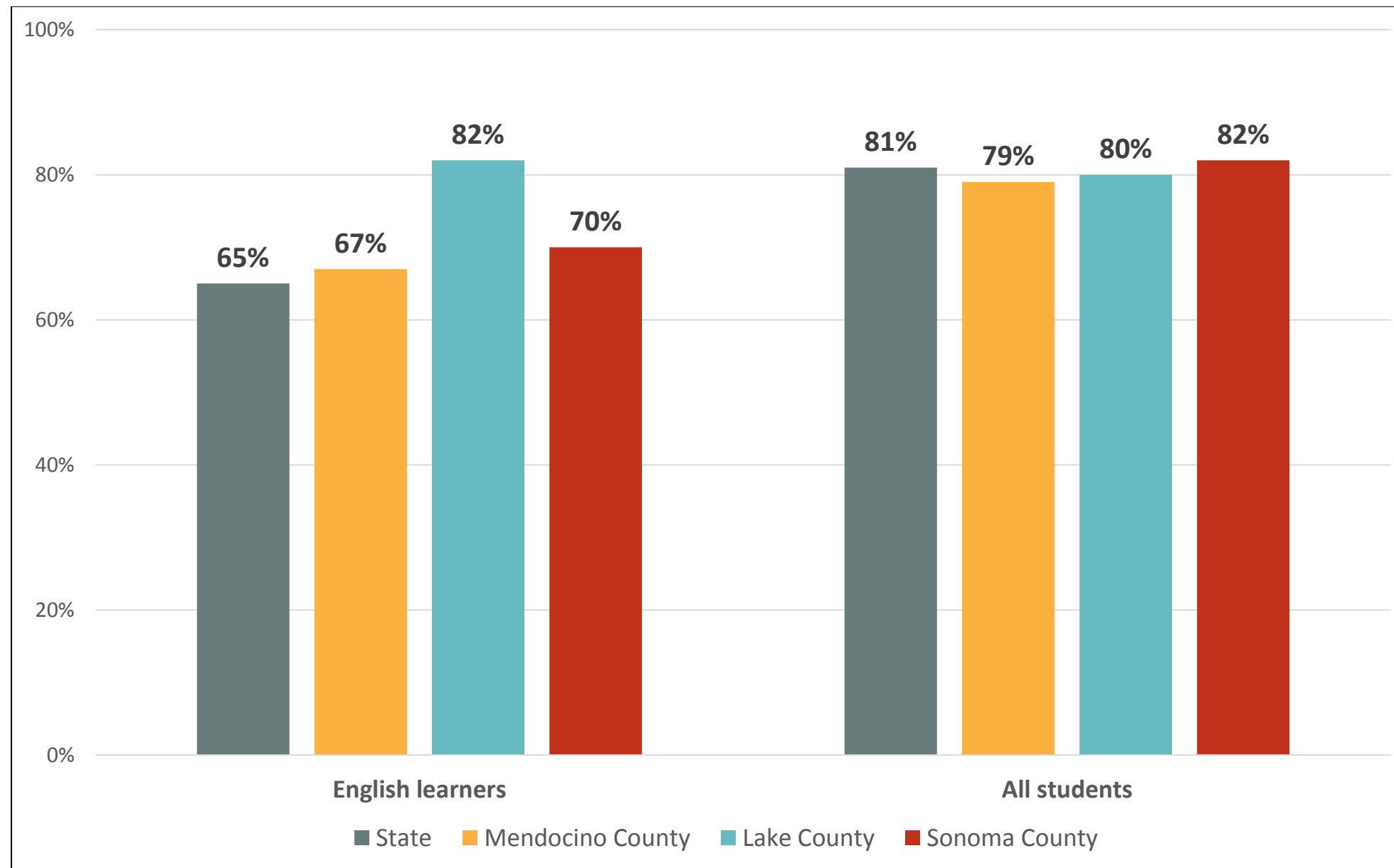

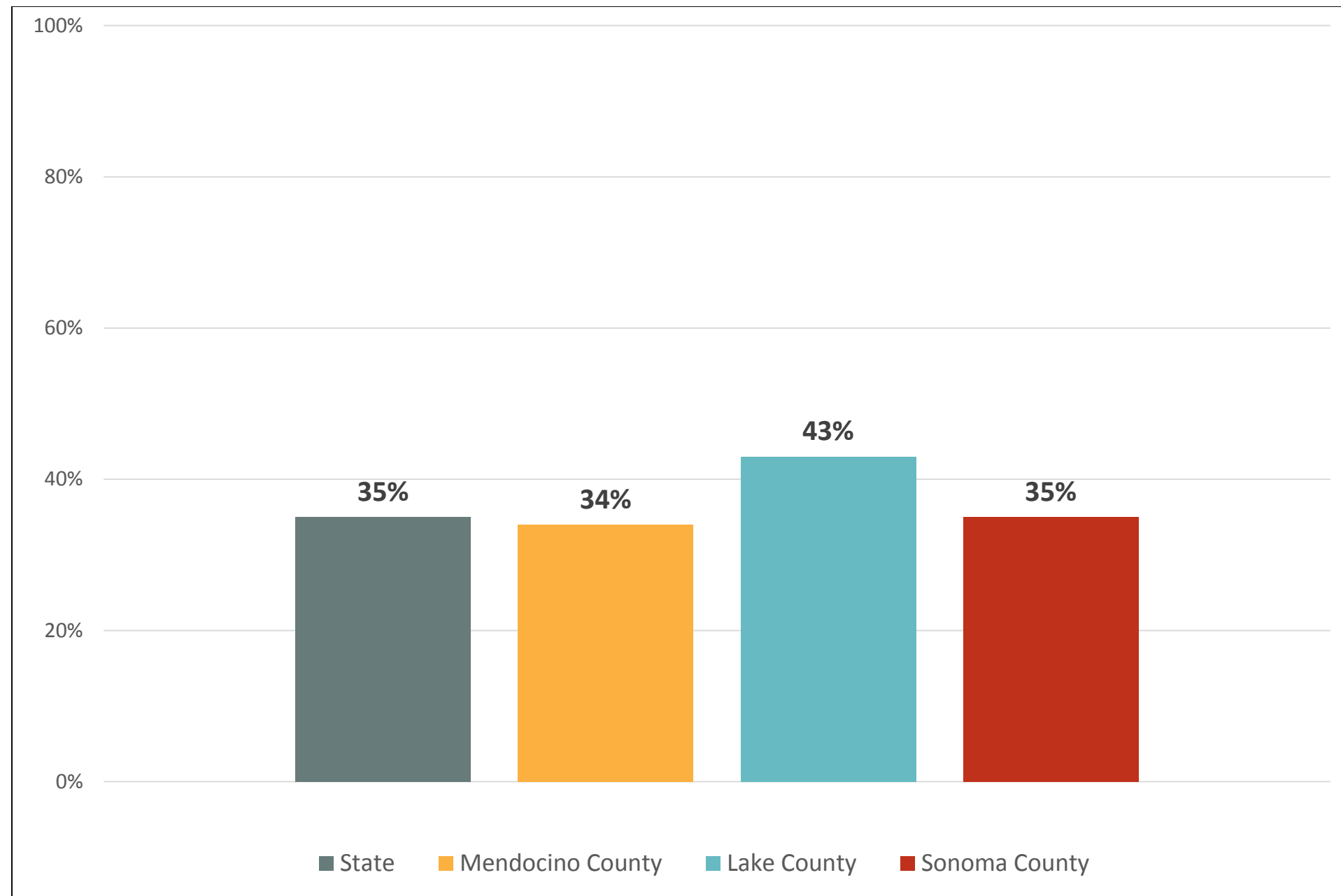

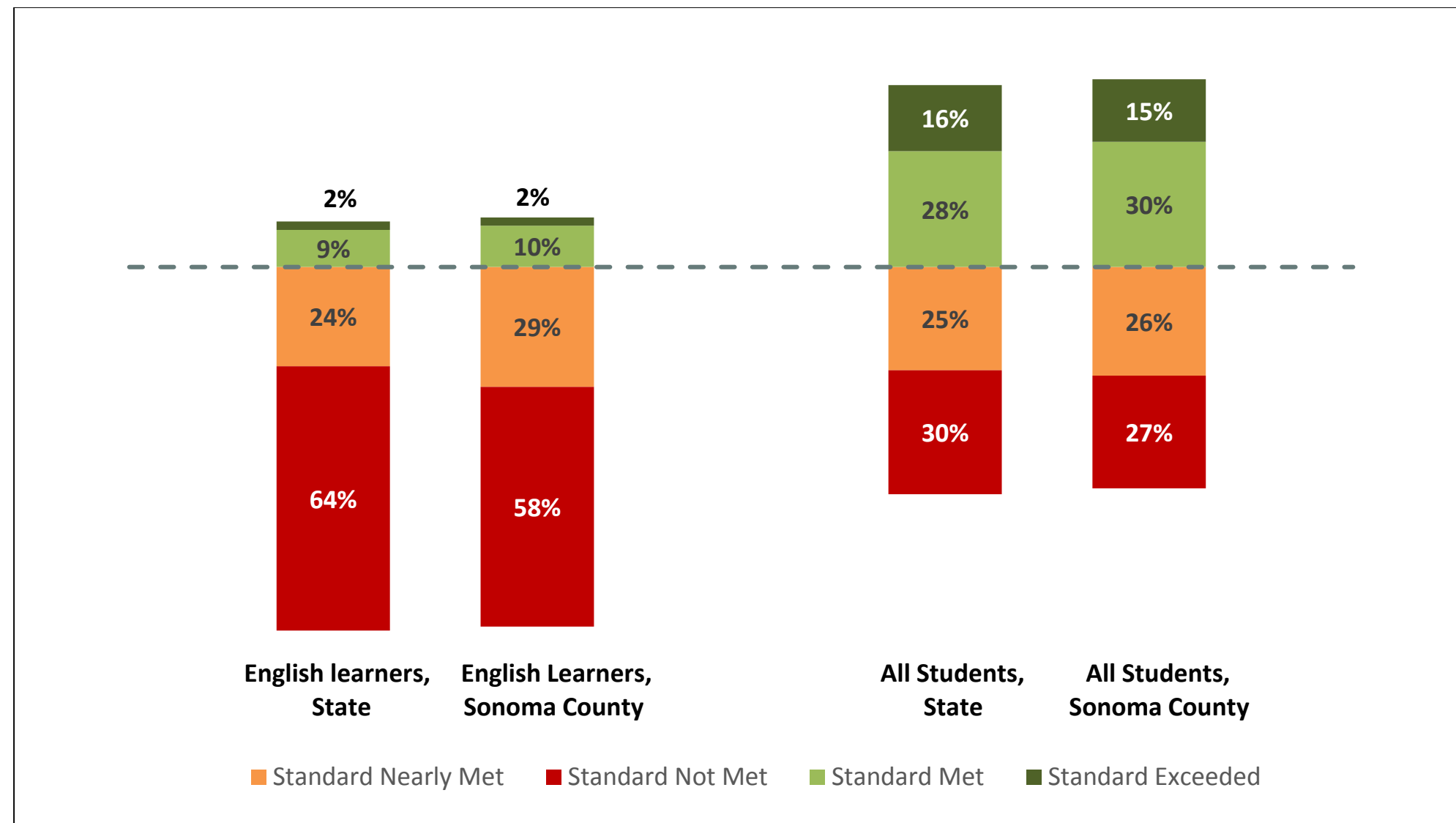
Long-term English learner* rates, 2013-14

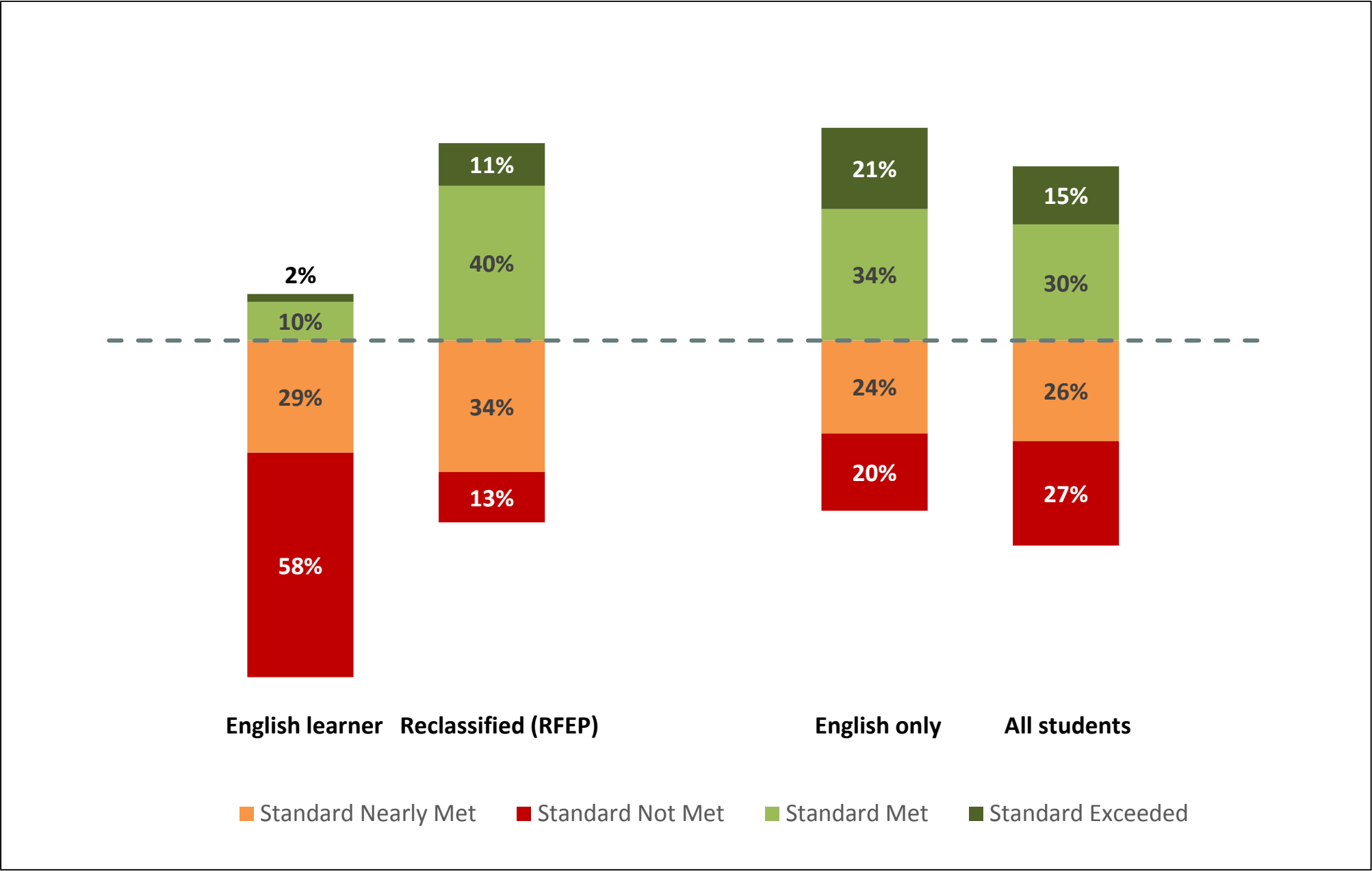

ELA SBAC performance across all grades by language status, Sonoma County vs. State, 2014-15



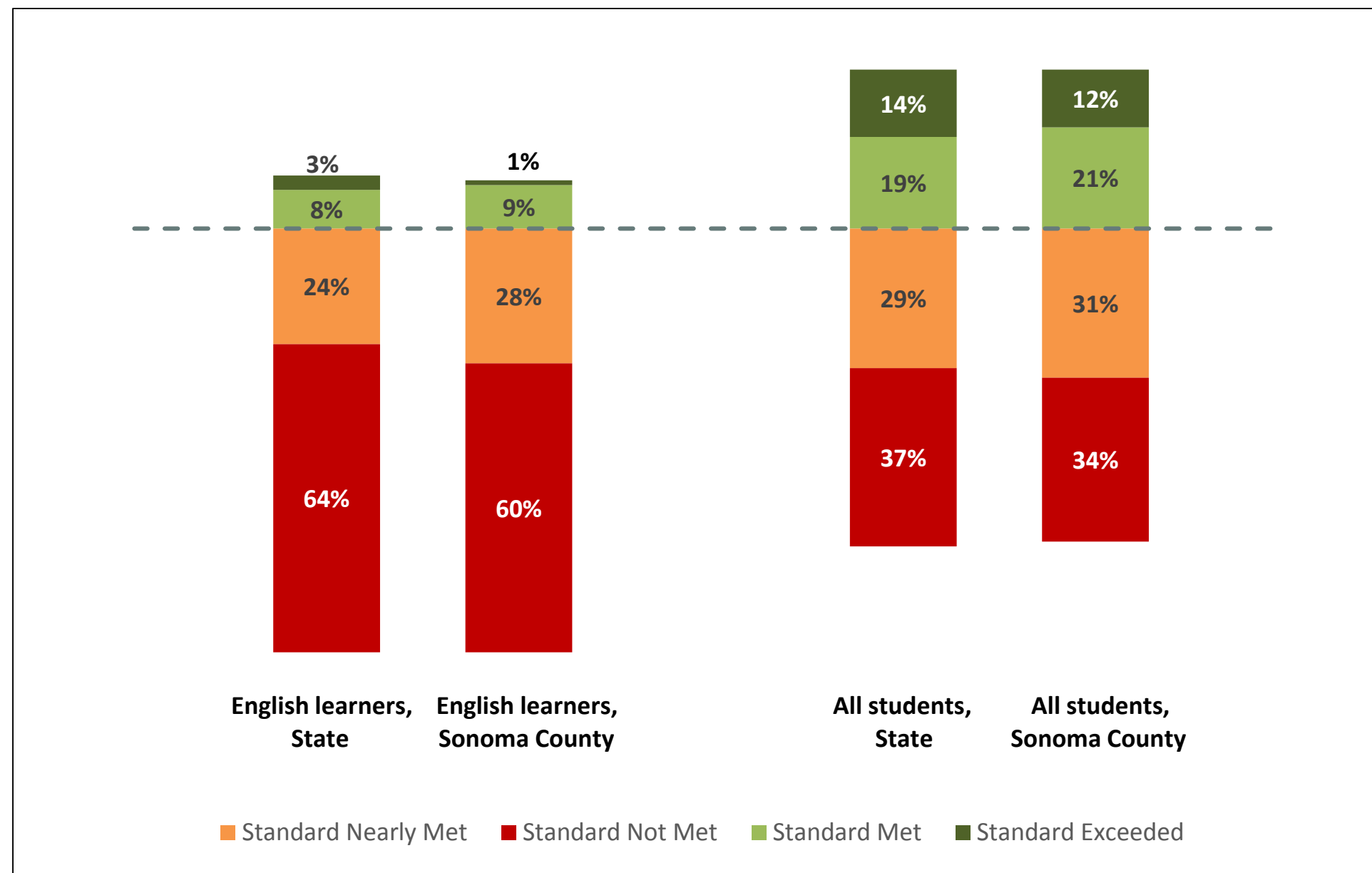

ELA SBAC performance across all grades by language status, Sonoma County, 2014-15



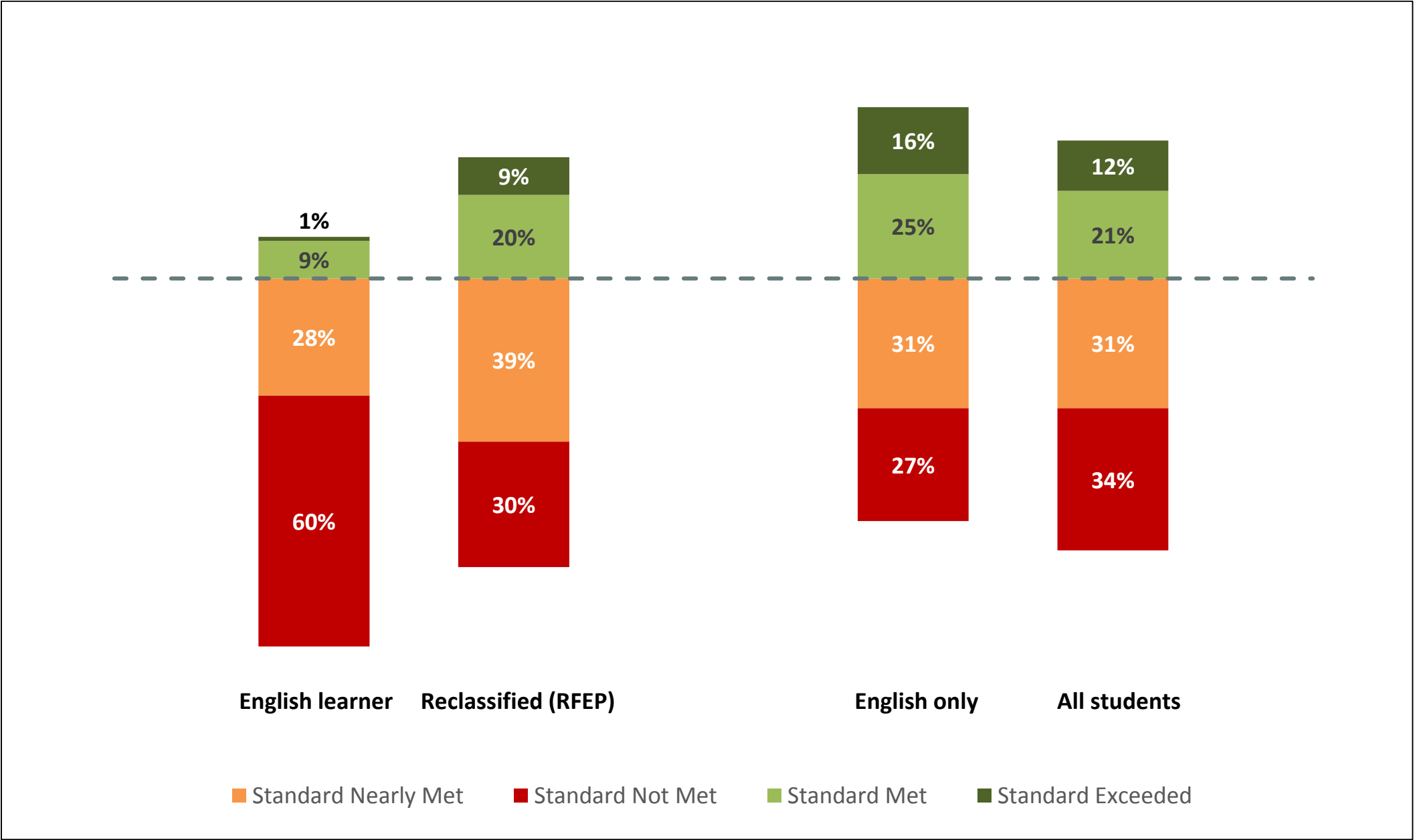

Promising practice: Sonoma County EL Collaborative

- Professional learning community dedicated to supporting teachers and other staff who work with ELs.
