



#### Cohort graduation rates, 2013-14





#### Long-term English learner\* rates, 2013-14




# ELA SBAC performance across all grades by language status, Sonoma County vs. State, 2014-15




## ELA SBAC performance across all grades by language status, Sonoma County, 2014-15
