
# Covid-19 Vaccine Clinics for Students & Families May 12, 16, & 23

Partnership between Sonoma County Office of Education, Safeway, Sonoma County School Districts, and Sonoma County Department of Health Services leads COVID-19 vaccine clinic for students, families, and the community

### Who is Eligible?

Any student, family, or community member age 16+.

Vaccines for anyone 12+ years old will be available beginning May 16 pending CDC approval.





The clinic will administer the Pfizer vaccine.

Students under age 18 need parental consent. If a parent is unable to attend they must provide written consent for vaccination for their child. This form can be accessed and printed when registering online.



"Being vaccinated is one of the best ways students can enjoy the academic and extracurricular aspects of school while protecting themselves, their families, and their friends," said Steve Herrington, Sonoma County Superintendent of Schools.
