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EOY Deadline Suspended/ Amendment Window Extended

Submission	Original Deadline	New Deadline
EOY Certification Deadline	July 31, 2017	Suspended
EOY Close of Amendment Window	August 11, 2017	August 25, 2017 (added 2 weeks)

- EOY 1, 2, and 3 have been moved to August 25, in order to accommodate a defect fix.
- Letters will not be sent to superintendents of local educational agencies (LEAs) that do not certify by July 31.
- LEAs with certification errors should continue to resolve errors as soon as possible in order to focus on reconciling the certification reports.

NEW DATAQUEST LISTSERV

PURGING OF FORMER FOSTER YOUTH REPORT

Report 5.9 - **Former Foster Youth** – *Student List* only counts students who stopped being a foster youth in the current academic year.



The *Former Foster Youth* report does not span academic years.



After the weekly upload on July 7, 2017 the report will be refreshed to reflect students changing foster status in the 2017–18 academic year.



The report will start afresh for the 2017–18 academic year and will include students who are reported to the California Department of Education (CDE) as no longer meeting the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) definition of foster youth.

PREPARING FOR DIRECT CERTIFICATION COUNTS DURING JULY AND AUGUST

Students that are exited with a Student Exit Reason Code of anything other than an *E155 – Year End Enrollment Exit* will not be sent over for direct certification matching until subsequent enrollment records for the new academic year are received in CALPADS

Direct Certification Counts Could be Significantly Lower Than Expected


- Until subsequent enrollments are submitted to CALPADS.
- This will most significantly affect any schools serving grades K–6 that choose to exit their students with *Student Exit Reason Code E450 – Pre-K–6 Exit*, because these students are not sent over for direct certification matching

Remember...

- Only students with a Student Exit Reason Code of *E155* continue to be sent over for matching since it is expected that they will return.
- It is recommended that all enrollments for the new academic year be submitted to CALPADS prior to August 1, 2017 so that these students can be matched for the August direct certification extract.

REVISED GUIDANCE FOR UPDATING PRIMARY DISABILITY


The intent is to capture only one special education record per student/school, even if the primary disability code changes over time.



If the disability code changes, local educational agencies (LEAs) should update (replace) the existing record to reflect the most current code.



The Start Date should remain the original start date from the first special education program record.



Students can have multiple open special education program records across schools/LEAs, but only one open record per school is allowed.

IMPORTANT

This is an important addendum to CALPADS Update Flash #129 (sent July 21) and to the listserv message sent (July 24) regarding EOY 1 submission processing temporarily disabled.

Important

Regarding the note in Flash #129 about the need to un-mark (by August 1) EOY 1 revisions that were marked as "In Review": The CALPADS Team has already taken care of this for you. This revision was removed along with all the other EOY 1 revisions.

Due to incorrect CTE report logic, the EOY 1 snapshots with revision status of *Certified*, *In Review*, *Revised Uncertified*, and *Decertify* have been purged. LEAs will NOT have access to any revision created before July 24.

EOY 1 is the only submission experiencing problems.

Important

LEAs will **NOT** have to re-load the EOY 1 data files (CRSC, SCSC or SCTE extracts), but they must redo their certification steps once the system generates new snapshot revisions next week (after the August 1 maintenance fix).

Again, the EOY 1 revisions previously displayed are no longer available, and EOY 1 snapshot reports must be regenerated. LEAs that certified EOY 1 will need to review a new set of snapshot reports and certify again after the August 1 maintenance fix.

Important

EOY 2 and EOY 3 snapshot revisions and certifications are **NOT** impacted. LEAs do not need to redo any work in EOY 2 or EOY 3.

LEAs can continue to work on EOY 2 and EOY 3 submissions. EOY 2 & 3 revisions are not impacted by the report problems in EOY 1.

If You Have Not Certified...

- Analyze and resolve fatal certification errors
- Review preliminary reports and make corrections as needed
- Distribute reports to data stewards for verification and signatures
- Print certified reports for records
- Districts must certify Level 1 and Level 2 for all EOY reporting even if the certify 0 student counts
- Exit all student with the appropriate codes. No student should remain active after July 1.
