2017-18 School Year

- Information Day/Census Day October 4, 2017
- Fall 1 Certification deadline is December 15, 2017
 - Amendment deadline is January 26, 2018
- Check Fall 1 certification reports for accuracy
- Check for Anomalies – Must be 2% or lower to certify (CCE and MID)
- Look at the 1.17 Report and verify all the fields that qualify for funding
- Update homeless students status
 - If a student became homeless due to the fires on October 9th, they will not count in the Fall 1 counts.
 - If a student was enrolled in your district on or before October 4th, and a homeless status was determined due to the fires; the student qualifies for free lunch.
 - The free/reduced lunch status is used till October 31st for Fall 1 counts.
- Verify Migrant status – expires after 3 years
 - Qualifies for free lunch
- Verify EL status
- Verify Parent Education Level
 - Highest level of education in the home is not a High School graduate
 - This will count in the socio-economically disadvantaged category
 - Does not qualify for free/reduced lunch
- Verify Foster Youth
 - A Foster Youth should be appointed by the court and have a Foster ID
- Direct Certification
 - The November pull will be allowed and counted for Fall 1 counts
 - Direct Certification is now pulling free/reduced priced meals
- Free/Reduced Applications
 - Can be used for the Fall 1 counts up to October 31st
- Before certification
 - Get all certification reports signed off by subject level administrators
