California Department of Education (CDE), Child Development Division (CDD)	Child Care Salary/Retention Incentive Program (AB 212) (CRET)	\$75,857	Encourages and rewards continued professional development through education and training by providing financial incentives to individuals working in state-subsidized early care and education programs.
Sonoma County First 5 Commission (includes First 5 California matching funds)	Comprehensive Approaches to Raising Educational Standards (CARES)	\$527,789	Encourages and rewards continued professional development through education and training by providing financial incentives to individuals working with 0-5 year-olds in early care and education programs.
Sonoma County First 5 Commission	Gateway to Quality (G2Q)	\$85,000	Provides external Environment Rating Scale and CLASS assessments for First 5 funded Gateway to Quality Mini-grant program, and other First 5 funded programs
Sonoma County Human Services Department	READY	\$17,608	Provides external Environment Rating Scale and CLASS assessments for providers participating in READY
