Important Dates

Changes to CBEDS-ORA

- A letter dated March 27, 2017 was sent to Administrators for districts and charters with details of changes to the 2017-18 data collection.
- Removed – Truancy and Educational Calendar
- Reordered
 - Parental Exception Waivers is now Section C.
 - Educational Calendar, year-round calendar options in Section D have been reordered.
 - Estimated Number of Teacher Hires (for independently reporting charter schools) is now Section E.
 - Increased Learning Time (for schools participating in the School Improvement Grant [SIG]) is now Section F.
 - School Year Minutes (for schools participating in the SIG) is now Section G.

CALPADS Update Flash #125

- Fall 2 final deadline is March 31, 2017
- After any amendment window closes, all certified data is a permanent record and the data cannot be changed.



SENR File Changes on May 9, 2017

The collection of two new data elements, Golden State Seal Merit Diploma and State Seal of Biliteracy, will be added to the Student Enrollment (SENR) file type on May 9, 2017.

LEAs will need to work with the student information system (SIS) vendor to make sure they have the ability to generate the new SENR extract that includes the two new fields.

ATTENDANCE DATA FOR CHRONIC ABSENTEEISM (STAS)

- The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) requires states to report chronic absenteeism rates for schools.
- The STAS data will be required for the first time as part of the 2016–17 End-of-Year (EOY) 3 - Student Discipline data submission.
- Please note that the absenteeism data collected through CALPADS will NOT replace the average daily attendance (ADA) data submitted to the CDE for purposes of funding the Local Control Funding Formula.
- The CALPADS team will provide a special training course in April and May independent of the EOY submission training to help LEAs prepare for the data collection.
