CalSAAS – Assignment Monitoring

- Early May – CDE provides Fall 2 data to Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC)
- Assignment monitoring through CalSAAS will begin in June 2020 and COEs will have 90 days to certify misassignments

End of Year (EOY) 1-4 Deadlines and Things to Know

- Initial certification deadline is July 31, 2020
- Amendment window ends **August 28, 2020**
- EOY 3 and EOY 4 require SELPA-level approval in addition to LEA-level approval
- EOY 3 - LEAs should submit all the incidents and results that occurred during the school year (through June 30, 2020), including any incidents and results that occurred or may occur subsequent to the LEA transitioning to distance learning. The LEA will need to work with the nonpublic schools (NPS) to collect and report the data that reflects the time students attended the NPS during the school year.

COVID-19 Updates

- Students who are eligible for Free or Reduced-Price Meals (FRPM) under the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) can receive food benefits under the Pandemic-EBT (P-EBT) program administered by the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) in collaboration with the CDE. Under the P-EBT program, families receive funds per eligible student that can be used on food and groceries.
- Students who are directly certified for FRPM based on the statewide match conducted through CALPADS, or who are identified as foster based on the statewide match with CDSS, will receive extra food benefits without applying to the P-EBT program. As these students are identified through the statewide matches, the CDE will continue to provide these students to CDSS for benefits. However, students who become *newly* eligible for free or reduced-price meals solely through an NSLP application, or an updated migrant or homeless status, can only be identified through the submission of a program record to CALPADS. **Therefore, LEAs should continue to update CALPADS through the end of the school year with new enrollments and program updates for Migrant (135), Free Meal Program (181), Reduced-Price Meal Program (182), and Homeless (191).**

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On Going CALPADS Maintenance

- Enroll new students and exit transferring students in their local student information system (SIS), even during school closures
- Maintain CALPADS data, as the SIS are updated, by updating CALPADS with enrollments (SENR), and other student information that is known (SINF, SPRG, SELA, SPED files)
- Resolve CCEs
