**Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2023 and Medi-Cal Redeterminations:**

***Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2023***

With the passage of this bill, the continuous coverage requirements that paused all Medi-Cal redeterminations would be decoupled from the Public Health Emergency (PHE) termination date as of March 31, 2023. Setting the stage for the resumption of Medi-Cal redeterminations on April 1, 2023.

Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) have developed outreach campaigns and materials for states to use to ensure families to do not lose coverage.
