

SCOE Blog guidelines and protocols

The “blog” pages on the SCOE website are designed to promote information sharing on education issues of interest to Sonoma County schools and communities. Some of the blog pages are structured to accept comments and/or be shared via social media.

Comments on blog posts are accepted from users who are logged in to their SCOE accounts (the same accounts that are used for online registration). SCOE’s expectation is that individuals posting comments will communicate in a respectful, courteous, and professional manner. Users are personally responsible for the content of their comments.

The views expressed in the blog posts and comments are those of the users and do not necessarily reflect SCOE’s position. References to specific commercial products or services do not imply endorsement or recommendation of those products or services.

Please note that SCOE’s blog pages and the related public comments are regularly monitored. If a comment is inappropriate, it will be removed. Comments that are obscene, libelous, or intended to incite or disrupt are considered inappropriate. Also inappropriate are comments that constitute discrimination or harassment, are of a commercial or political nature, or don’t relate to the purpose of the blog.
