## RADIO & TELEVISION STATION GUIDE

We want you to know that our classes have plans and preparations for major emergency situations. Each classroom has an emergency reference guide as well as supplies that include water, food, blankets, and basic medical supplies.

- Parents are asked to not telephone the school.
- Streets should be kept as open as much as possible for emergency vehicles.
- Parents should turn on a Sonoma County radio station (AM or FM). Information and instructions for picking up children during or after an emergency will be given over the radio. Emergency information from the Office of Emergency Services (OES) will be broadcasted on AM and FM radio through the Emergency Alert System (EAS). The following EAS stations serve the Sonoma County area. KSRO is the only station having fall-out protected facilities; however, other unprotected but authorized EAS stations will continue to operate as conditions permit.
