

Sonoma County Locations of Grab-and-Go Meal Service for Students

City of Healdsburg:

Healdsburg Unified School District will provide grab-and-go meals during site closures due to COVID-19. All children ages 1 to 18 will receive a free breakfast and a free lunch Monday - Friday, March 23 – April 4, from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm at the following sites:

City of Windsor:
